Uptown Art corporate, owners and artists are all committed to keeping our guests safe. As you are likely aware, the Coronavirus has begun to spread throughout the United States and has entered Ohio, Kentucky and Indiana.

It is still very early to tell how this virus will affect the community, but we will follow local and state guidelines and recommendations for conducting business safely. Our studios have begun a more thorough process of cleaning and disinfecting commonly touched surfaces, but we realize that will not completely eradicate any virus that may be present.

Healthy Habits to help prevent the Coronavirus:

Avoid close contact.

Stay home when you are sick.

Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth.

Cover your mouth and nose (with a tissue when coughing or sneezing)

Clean your hands (wash with soap and water for at least 20 seconds)

In the event you need to cancel your seat(s) for a class, the regular policy will remain in place. All cancelled seats will be given a studio credit to use toward a future class. In the event the studio will need to shut down, class credits will be given, and the classes will be rescheduled at a later date. We want everyone to remain healthy and safe and we will be closely following the recommendations from the CDC as well as local authorities.
